SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS**

The following is a summary of changes to the IAM National 401(k) Fund's 2017 Summary Plan Description ("SPD"). This Summary of Material Modifications ("SMM") supplements or modifies the information in your SPD regarding the Plan. Please keep this document with your copy of the 2017 SPD for future reference.

1. Effective for claims for disability benefits filed on or after April 1, 2018 (Page 7 of the SPD – "When Can I Receive Benefits from the Plan?"):

The Board of Trustees amended the Plan to clarify that the Trustees do not have discretion in the determination as to whether a Participant is totally and permanently disabled. A Participant is totally and permanently disabled under the Plan if he or she applies for and is entitled to receive a disability pension from the IAM National Pension Fund, any other qualified pension plan sponsored by the Contributing Employer or from any governmental plan.

2. As of January 1, 2019, the following change was made on the Board of Trustees (Page 14 of the SPD):
